



# Black Marriage Day 2022



In honor and in memory of two of our mentors in supporting marriages and families, Tariq Saleem Ziyad and his lovely departed wife, Krsnanandini Dasi, founders of the Dasi-Ziyad Family Institute, on Saturday, March 26, 2022, The Couples Club will host Black Marriage Day, which DZFI spearheaded in the Greater Cleveland area on multiple occasions over the past decade.





Established by the Wedded Bliss Foundation, Black Marriage Day started in 2003 with just 30 cities participating and has blossomed into a collective of over 300 communities.

Marriage and family is being looked at again as institution of hope for saving children and couples. In the 1960's and 70's, most Black children grew up in two parent homes and we are realizing that couples who have healthy skills, tools, commitment and a spiritual foundation, are the basis of healthy societies.

Because The Couples Club is a culturally INCLUSIVE organization to support and encourage healthy relationships, we want to celebrate Black Marriage Day with people of all races and nationalities on Saturday, March 26, 2022, as did DZFI!

Although the location is yet to be confirmed, it is the plan of The Couples Club to carry out the vision of DZFI by gathering up to 100 couples to renew their wedding vows!

Saturday morning, registered couples will arrive at the venue at 9am to sign in and fellowship with a continental breakfast. There will then be an icebreaker/get acquainted session. Couples will partake in a joint session for couples, then there will be a split session for the men and the women, followed by lunch. After lunch, the couples will reconvene for one last joint session. There will then be a one-hour break where couples will be able to have a little free time at the venue, fellowship with other couples, or perhaps change clothes for the "wedding"! At 4pm, all couples will prepare to process into the sanctuary for this renewal ceremony. Each couple will be able to invite up to four guests to attend as well. After the celebration ceremony, all of the couples and their guests will retire to the fellowship hall for a cake and punch reception!

AND as an added BONUS, The Couples Club has two engaged couples who are choosing to get married for the FIRST time to each other as their fellow club members recommit!

# Things Mama Never Told You......"Or Maybe I Wasn't Listening.......

I have decided to add a column to our newsletter called, "Things Mama Never Told You....or Maybe I Wasn't Listening....."

How many of us know that there are a TON of those things! Things that we wish our parents had told us about....and then realistically, if we think back there were conversations about some things but maybe we just didn't want to hear it.

Many of us when we become that "Magic" #18 and go off to college, those credit card applications come flying our way! So I "Heard" my dad always say that it was important to make a name for yourself. To me, that meant get lots of credit cards...and like most college students, I DID!!!! I had every one known to man!...and I knew how to get them for others and mess up everyone else's credit, because they, like me, didn't always comprehend, the whole "buy now, PAY later" concept of the credit card! So many of us now know or eventually learned the hard way about credit card debt.

Well, here is one that many of us do not know.

I was sitting in a meeting with my personal banker having a personal consultation. I shared how I am in the process of repairing and rebuilding my credit score. We talked and shared about the whole credit card issue that many people experience. Then he shared that his credit score took a huge attack from an emergency room visit because he did not have any medical insurance. He also shared that as he works in his current role, he comes across many people in similar situations whose credit score suffered from medical and hospital bills! That was something that this young man wished someone had told him.

I've got one more.

Working as a social worker for over 25 years, I learned that some things NEVER go away! We know that about some criminal records, but how many people realize that when a "case" is opened relative to your family in the child welfare system, those records never go away. When an individual has what is considered to be a "substantiated" case of child abuse or neglect at age 19, 22, 27, 30 or any young age.....and then at age 42, 50, or even 65 and now you have your life completely together, home owner, business owner, self sustained and now you want to give back and help someone else in the family or perhaps you'd like a job or even a volunteer position working in a field helping or working with children. Because of choices that we may have made in our youth, those things follow us for the rest of our lives. When the background check is completed at age 46, this information pops up from age 21...a much-less cautious time! This is real stuff and one of those things that many people wish Mama or somebody would have told them.

Maybe there is some little bit of wisdom that you wished that someone had told your younger self. # Youth News

Pressing through the pandemic, the youth outreach programs have been continuing to teach, educate, and expose our young people to lots of great things!

We have three very recent events. The first is an ongoing partnership with OK, Inc. where staff from the former, Operation Keepsake, have traveled some as far as Youngstown, Ohio to share their curriculum with our young people. Whereas Operation Keepsake was an abstinence program which encouraged its participants to abstain from having sex until marriage, their new ploy is to encourage youth to set goals for themselves and to "follow their dreams". They discuss with the participants how making poor choices or participating in "risky Behaviours" can deter or detain them reaching the goals that they set for themselves.

This film tells the story of how a once atheist couple, later come to accept Christ, and made it their mission to help save and help Jewish people from Nazi soldiers. There is a scene where the main character protected someone who even told her that if tables were turned that he would not have done the same for her. This was a tale of forgiveness. ### Date Vs. "DATING"

As most people know, The Couples Club is an organization of married, engaged, and "Dating" couples. What exactly constitutes a "dating" couple? So glad that you asked.

For the purposes of The Couples Club, we are a group of monogamous couples in relationships with one man and one woman.

With The Couples Club, should a single person desire to attend one of our events, that person could choose to bring a "date" to the event. Those two individuals are both single and are aware that they are not in a relationship but that they are ON a "Date". In this sense, "Date" is a noun. She had never attended such and was very interested. This also is okay because she IS his date. Date being person. At the TCC event, during the icebreaker or introductions, they would introduce themselves individually as each other's DATE. Example: "Hi, I'm John. This is my DATE, Brenda. I heard about the Sip & Paint and wanted to come check it out. Brenda is my neighbor and had never been

to a Sip & Paint, so I asked her if she'd like to come with me."




